We are entering our fourth year of this program. Our main focus is to create a positive school climate that fosters cooperation, academic excellence, respect, responsibility, and safety.

During the first few weeks of school and various times throughout the school year, our students will be learning about PBIS and its expectations. The PBIS Committee created this program to promote the core values of RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, and SAFETY for all students and the entire CMS community.

In the last few years our PBIS program displayed posters in every classroom, restroom, hallways, stairways, and computer lab, updated and tweaked handbooks, created a quick reference guide for staff to streamline information, increased use of Charger Bucks, and established a creative partnership for incentives with our school store. This year we are focusing on bringing PBIS into the classrooms, with each grade level or Team developing a Classroom management plan that will be consistently implemented with all students.
